**Carnival Days**

Flight Crew (pre canskaters) are at the VERY beginning of the first half of the show. If you are in the first half of the show, please be at the arena at 1:30 PM and 6:30 PM on Saturday and 1:30 PM on Sunday. If you are in the second half of the show, please be at the arena by 2:00 PM and 7:00 PM on Saturday and 2:00 PM on Sunday.

### **Costumes**

Please make sure your skater's costume is completely covered when they are in the arena. All skaters should have clean skates with white laces for girls and black laces for boys. Beige skating tights for all dresses and skirts (unless specified otherwise). **DO NOT** use bobby pins, they slip out of hair and can cause skaters to fall. Please give consideration to dressing your skater in appropriately coloured undergarments (special consideration for those skaters in white costumes). **NO** glitter products may be used in the arena or dressing rooms. ### **Dressing Rooms**

On carnival day there will be a "group mom" who will stay with the skaters in each dressing room. Unfortunately, we cannot have dads in the girls dressing rooms, until they skate. There will be chairs set up in the dressing room hallway for those dads who need to tie skates. There will be an alternative change room for male skaters. Dressing rooms will be labeled. **Remember:** No food, drinks or glitter allowed in the dressing rooms.

### **Arriving at the arena**

Please go directly to your dressing room when you arrive at the arena or at the scheduled time, if you are in the second half. Skaters will be asked to remain in the dressing rooms until they skate. Once they are finished their number, they will go back to their assigned dressing room. **Flight Crew must be picked up immediately after their number.** All **Canskate** groups who perform in the first half must be picked up at intermission so as to not disrupt the show. Group moms will stay in the dressing room with the skaters until all skaters have been picked up.

### **Admission**

Parent passes **MUST** be purchased by Thursday April 4th. Parent passes will **NOT** be available at the door. A parent pass allows you into all three shows. The pass is \$13.00 for the weekend and each family is allowed 2 parent passes. This year we are offering a sibling pass for children ages 6-10. The pass is \$13.00 and allows the child into all three shows. Sibling passes **MUST** be purchased by Thursday April 4th, and will **NOT** be available at the door. General admission tickets can be purchased at the door or in advance for \$13.00/show for adults and \$9.00/show for students ages 6-18. Children 5 and under are free of charge. Tickets will be available in the Snack Bar area and a full schedule of ticket sales is posted on the notice board.

### **Saturday Night Family Party 8:30 PM - MIDNIGHT**

On Saturday after the show there will be a dance/party for skaters and their families at the **Polish Hall (picture day location) on Exmouth Street.** There will be prizes for kids to win throughout the

night. There will be a DJ and a cash bar. Please bring a snack to share (sign up on the notice board) Tickets are \$5.00/person and are available during carnival ticket sales as well as at the door. Everyone is welcome!

### **Carnival Photos and Videos**

Pictures ordered on picture day are in and will be available for pick up this week. Please check the notice board for days and times.

John Beaugrand of JB Productions is recording the Sunday show. You may order a DVD copy of the show. Envelopes for DVD orders will be available during ticket sales, rehearsal night, as well as during the carnival shows. Cost is \$34.00 for DVD which includes HST and shipping fees. Payment by cash or cheque.

### **Reserving Seats on Carnival Days**

In the past, people have used blankets to save seats between shows. Please take note that this will not be permitted. We must allow for fair access to seating for all guests, and give the arena staff full access to all seating areas between shows for cleaning. Thank you for your cooperation. There are designated areas for wheelchair access. Please let us know if you require access to these areas.

### **Volunteers**

If you are interested in volunteering, we are looking for volunteers to help set up on Thursday April 4th evening, Friday April 5th during the day, as well as volunteers to run spotlights, sell flowers and programs, and take on the role of dressing room moms. Volunteering is a great opportunity to get a sneak peak behind the scenes of our show! We realize that Friday April 5th is also a PD Day. Unfortunately, young skaters are not permitted at the area during the day. There will be heavy machinery and construction materials - we are asking for adult help only, on Friday April 5th.
